

Disclosure on the transferability of credits shall be as follows in Tennessee:

Credits earned at the Dental Staff School may not transfer to another educational institution. Credits earned at another educational institution may not be accepted by the Dental Staff School. You should obtain confirmation that the Dental Staff School will accept any credits you have earned at another educational institution before you execute an enrollment contract or agreement. You should also contact any educational institutions that you may want to transfer credits earned at the Dental Staff School to determine if such institutions will accept credits earned at the Dental Staff School prior to executing an enrollment contract or agreement. The ability to transfer credits from the Dental Staff School to another educational institution may be very limited. Your credits may not transfer and you may have to repeat courses previously taken at the Dental Staff School if you enroll in another educational institution. You should never assume that credits will transfer to or from any educational institution. It is highly recommended and you are advised to make certain that you know the transfer of credit policy of the Dental Staff School and of any other educational institutions you may in the future want to transfer the credits earned at the Dental Staff School before you execute an enrollment contract or agreement.

The Dental Staff School is authorized by the Tennessee Higher Education Commission. This authorization must be renewed each year and is based on an evaluation by minimum standards concerning quality of education, ethical business practices, health and safety, and fiscal responsibility.

The Dental Staff School is a special purpose institution. That purpose of the Dental Staff School strives to offer a highly efficient and thorough dental assistant course that prepares students the skills necessary to perform the duties required of a dental assistant. Our aim is to provide effective, affordable training that is educational, practical, and convenient, presented in a student directed format. This purpose does not include preparing students for further college study. Students should be aware that transfer of credit is always the responsibility of the receiving institution. Whether or not credits transfer is solely up to the receiving institution. Any student interested in transferring credit hours should check with the receiving institution directly to determine to what extent, if any, credit hours can be transferred.
